


Leap of Faith SEPTEMBER 2023







BIBLE QUIZ ANSWERS

1) One day Jesus asked His disciples, "Who do the people think I am?" The disciples mentioned John the Baptist, Elijah, Jeremiah or other prophets. Then Jesus asked, "But what about you? Who do you say I am?" Then Peter answered, _____

The Correct Answer is: "You are the Messiah, the Son of the living God."

Matthew 16:13-16, Mark 8:27-29, Luke 9:18-20. Up until this time Jesus' disciples did not know His true identity. Peter was the first of the twelve to realize that Jesus was the Messiah, or Christ, that the Jewish people had waited so many years for.

2) Where were Jesus and the disciples when this happened?

The Correct Answer is: Caesarea Philippi

Matthew 16:13, Mark 8:27. Caesarea Philippi was a city about 20 miles (32 km) north of the Sea of Galilee, on the slope of Mount Hermon.

3) Then Jesus said to Peter, "And I tell you, you are Peter, and on this ______ I will build my church, and the gates of Hades will not prevail against it."

The Correct Answer is: rock

<u>Matthew 16:18</u>. This is a play on words by Jesus; the name "Peter" meant "rock" in the original Greek Bible text. The Roman Catholic Church takes this verse to mean that Jesus appointed Peter the first pope, and all popes since that time have been Peter's successors. Protestants, of course, do not agree with that interpretation.

4) Jesus continued, "I will give you the keys of _____, and whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven."

The correct answer is: the kingdom of heaven

<u>Matthew 16:19</u>. The "keys of the kingdom of heaven" probably symbolized Peter's authority over establishing the Christian Church on earth. The meaning of "bind" and "loose" is not certain. Some commentators say it was an expression meaning to prohibit or allow. Others say it meant the power to not forgive or forgive sins.
