

## **Answers to the Bible Quiz**

1) What sacrifice did Mary and Joseph offer at that time?

The answer is: A pair of turtledoves or pigeons

<u>Luke 2:22-24</u>. Mary and Joseph took Jesus to Jerusalem, which is only a few miles from Bethlehem. The sacrifice of birds indicates Joseph and Mary were poor; a lamb would have been the usual sacrifice.

#### 3) What did Simeon say to Mary?

The answer is: "This child is destined for the falling and the rising of many in Israel, and to be a sign that will be opposed."

<u>Luke 2:28-35</u>. It had been revealed to Simeon that the coming of Jesus would cause great upheaval in Israel, and that His influence would extend to the Gentiles.

2) There was a man in Jerusalem called Simeon, who was righteous and devout. What had been revealed to Simeon by the Holy Spirit?

The answer is: He would not die before he had seen the Lord's Christ.
