- Assist handicapped people with transportation to and from doctors’ appointments.
- Assist them with shopping chores.
- Provide them with meals.
- Help children with their problems.
- Take an active role in supporting children.
- Provide transportation to and from their events.

- Help single parents by babysitting for free when needed.
