Bible Quiz Answers: Jesus is Raised from the Dead

1) Jesus was crucified on a Friday, and hastily laid in a tomb before the Sabbath began at sunset. Early Sunday morning, after the Sabbath was over, some women came to the tomb with spices to properly prepare Jesus' body for burial according to Jewish custom. Who was among these women?

The correct answer is : Mary Magdalene

Matthew 28:1, Mark 16:1, John 20:1. All four Gospels tell the same basic story of Jesus' resurrection, but they differ in some of the details. Mark also mentions Mary, mother of James, and Salome. Luke mentions Mary, mother of James, Joanna, and "others."

3) How did the women find out Jesus had risen from the dead?

The correct answer is: Someone at the tomb told them Jesus had risen.

Matthew 28:5-6, Mark 16:5-6, Luke 24:4-7, John 20:11-13. Matthew says it was an angel of the Lord. Mark says it was a young man dressed in a white robe. Luke says it was two men in clothes that gleamed like lightning. John says it was two angels in white. Perhaps this was such an awe-inspiring experience that no one knew how to describe it in human terms!

2) What did the women notice when they arrived at the tomb?

The correct answer is: The large stone covering the entrance to the tomb had been rolled away.

Matthew 28:2, Mark 16:3-4, Luke 24:2, John 20:1. In their haste and grief, the women had not thought about how to move the large stone until they were approaching the tomb (Mark 16:3).

4) One of the women saw the risen Jesus near the tomb, but did not recognize Him at first. Who did she mistake Him for?

The correct answer is: The gardener


John 20:13-16. Jesus' appearance was somehow different, yet similar after His resurrection. Not only Mary Magdalene, but also His disciples, failed to recognize Him at first.

Few people doubt that Jesus was a real person who lived, preached and was crucified by the Romans. But in our skeptical age many find it difficult to believe He actually rose from the dead. However, after seeing Him alive, Jesus' disciples had no doubt that Jesus had risen and was truly the Son of God. So powerful was their faith that they were willing to endure persecution and even death to spread the good news to the world!
